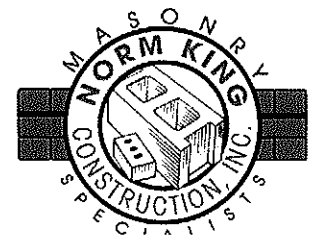
CMHA Euclid Belmore Project

The CMHA Euclid Belmore is the next project slated to start for us. Unfortunately, the site contractor ran into bad soil conditions & the project has been delayed. At this point we are anticipating starting the masonry the second week of February. The scope of the project is a cmu foundation with (3) cmu stairwells & (1) elevator. The remaining of the work is utility brick veneer with cast stone accents. In total there are approximately 63,000 utility brick, 16,000 cmu, 400 pieces of cast stone, and 100 yards of grout. We are actively pursuing more work & anticipate future work shortly.
